Modular Glass Fencing shall not be liable for the incorrect location of the fence or damage to the above utilities and the purchaser shall indemnify Modular Glass Fencing against any claims or damage made by any person or authority in respect of incorrect location or damage.

Although every care is taken Modular Glass Fencing will not accept liability for any remedial damage to surrounding landscaping (flowerbeds, turf, paintwork, paving, concrete or timber decking etc...).
